

Provincial Emergency Declaration Extended Until May 12

April 15, 2020

On April 14, 2020 the Government of Ontario extended the Declaration of Emergency and associated emergency measures, including the closure of non-essential workplaces, until May 12. This is an extension of the Declaration ordering closure of non-essential workplaces, last extended on April 11. With the extension of this Declaration, Registered **Denturists are reminded that they may only provide <u>urgent care</u> to patients.**

On a different note, I would like to thank all the members who completed their Registration Renewal. Despite all the other demands on you at this time, 91.5% of the members renewed by the end of the renewal period (yesterday).
