Council Votes to Waive the Fee Increase for the 2018-19 Fiscal Year:

The draft budget for the 2018-19 fiscal year was approved by Council. After which, Council voted to waive any fee increase for 2018-19.

Standards of Practice:

Conflict of Interest

Council approved the [Standard of Practice: Conflict of Interest](#) for implementation on October 1, 2018. The accompanying [Guide to the Standard of Practice: Conflict of Interest](#) was amended to include language that is permissive of revenue sharing. A webinar and self-directed learning assignment will be developed ahead of the implementation date. Stay tuned!

Jurisprudence Program:
