Legislative Changes:

Based on amendments to the Regulated Health Professions Act (1991), the following requirements came into effect on May 1, 2018. Additionally, three new sets of regulations have been enacted.

Key changes include:

- the definition of who is a patient for the purposes of sexual abuse ([Patient Criteria Under Subsection 1\(6\) of the Health Professions Procedural Code \(O. Reg. 260/18\)](#));
- immediate access to funding for patient counselling/therapy when sexual abuse is alleged;
- new mandatory reporting provisions, including the need to report any criminal or drug offences against a Member ([Information Prescribed Under Subsection 23\(2\) of the Health Professions Procedural Code \(O. Reg. 261/18\)](#)); and
- expanding the instances that require the mandatory revocation of a Member's registration certificate ([Prescribed Offences – Health Professions Procedural Code \(O. Reg. 262/18\)](#)).
