Notice to All Members of the College of Denturists of Ontario from the Registrar regarding a Letter from Fogler Rubinoff LLP

It was recently brought to the College's attention that a letter dated July 5, 2013 from the law firm Fogler Rubinoff LLP has been circulated to denturists in Ontario. The letter addresses the use of the "Procedure Codes" to which the Denturist Association of Canada (DAC) holds the copyright and the use of the trademark DD. It is not within the purview of the College to comment on the validity of the commercial assertions made in the letter. However, the College wishes to reassure all members who hold a current certificate of registration that they are entitled under section.8(1) of the *Denturism Act, 1991*, to use the restricted title "denturist".

The College will look into the matter respecting the use of the letters DD by registered denturists in Ontario.

Please note that it is only the College of Denturists of Ontario that is in the position to determine whether an act of professional misconduct has occurred.
