Dear Registered Denturists,

The College is currently seeking members of the profession to serve as Peer Assessors for the Peer and Practice Assessment component of the Quality Assurance Program!

Are you interested in serving as an assessor? Peer Assessors normally carry out 5-10 assessments each year. Each assessment takes approximately 2-3 hours and are conducted in-person at the member's primary site of practice. Assessors receive a per diem as well as reimbursement for expenses. Some assessments may be conducted remotely.

The Peer & Practice Assessment provides for peer-to-peer interaction around standards of care and practice and is an essential component of professional regulation ([Peer Assessment Components & Assessor Commitments](#)).
