Stakeholder Consultation

Dear Stakeholder,

At its September 6th, 2019 meeting, the Council of the College of Denturists of Ontario approved a draft of the Code of Ethics for stakeholder consultation.

Background

Registered Denturists are self-regulated professionals. This status obliges them to act competently and ethically in the practice of their profession and maintain recognized standards of care while observing professional values.

The College does not currently articulate expectations regarding approaches to ethical conduct other than section 47 of the Professional Misconduct Regulation which prohibits members from “engaging in conduct or performing an act, relevant to the practice of denturism, that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable, unethical or unprofessional.”
