



# COVID-19 Vaccination Scheduling

March 3, 2021

The Government of Ontario has begun COVID-19 vaccinations in a [three-phase vaccine distribution plan](#). Health care workers, including Registered Denturists, fall under Phase 1 of the plan as specified by the Ministry of Health's [Guidance for Prioritizing Health Care Workers for COVID-19 Vaccination](#).

Each of Ontario's 34 Local Public Health Units is responsible for the vaccine administration program in their area. As a health care worker, your eligibility to receive the vaccine will depend on the vaccine administration program details set by the Public Health Unit jurisdiction in which you live. The College encourages members to review information provided by their Local Public Health Units for the latest updates.

The College endeavours to update Registered Denturists with the most recent information when it is provided to us by a Public Health Unit. Not all Public Health Units communicate their vaccine administration program information to the College. As you can appreciate, with many local Public Health Units administering the vaccination program, the timeline for vaccination, availability of vaccines, and information regarding the scheduling of vaccinations varies widely across the province.

**Bottom Line:** The College will provide you with the pertinent information that it receives but we may not have the most up-to-date information if it has not been provided to us by the Public Health Unit(s).
