Dear Members and Stakeholders,

At its December 6, 2019 meeting, Council approved the draft Infection Prevention and Control Guidelines for stakeholder consultation.

Background

Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC) requires the attention and participation of all oral health care workers involved in the delivery of denturism care and service. This commitment by Registered Denturists and all individuals working in the practice environment will help prevent the spread of infectious microorganisms among and between patients and care providers.

This document aims to consolidate recommendations for IPAC best practices and procedures published by the Government of Ontario, Public Health Ontario, the Provincial Infectious Disease Advisory Committee, the Canadian Standards Association, and the College of Dental Hygienists of Ontario. The draft guidelines will provide Registered Denturists with a valuable resource tailored to the denturism practice.
