The content of the Objective Structured Clinical Examination is determined by the [Essential Competencies for Denturism Practice in Ontario](#). Candidates are encouraged to review the Competency Profile and the breakdown of each category including performance indicators and practice illustrations. The OSCE portion of the Qualifying Examination is administered provincially.

The clinical (OSCE) component of the Qualifying Examination reflects those competencies in content and importance, and are as follows:
