

## National Competency Profile for Registered Denturists

## **Online Survey**

The provincial regulatory authorities for Denturism have initiated a review and revision of the National Competency Profile for Registered Denturists. As you will be aware, competencies associated with the practice of Denturism change over time. The previous version of this document was developed and published in 2013, so it is time for a review and revision of these competencies.

This review can only be accomplished by the participation of Registered Denturists and **you are being asked to participate in an important online survey that is designed to validate essential competencies and performance indicators for denturists at entry-to-practice.** The results of this survey will be analyzed and used to create national level entry-to-practice competencies and performance indicators. These national level competencies and indicators will help standardize the quality of Denturism education across the country by informing Denturism course content. They will also assist in clarifying the requirements of Registered Denturists at entry-to-practice.

If you complete this survey, you are eligible to receive 4 unstructured Continuing Professional Development credits for the 2019-2020 reporting period. Some jurisdictions require a certificate of proof of completion of the survey and the option to print this certificate is provided at the end of the survey. Denturists registered with the CDO are not required to provide this proof of completion. The College trusts that those who claim those CPD credits will have done the requisite work.
