Peer Circles

This Continuing Professional Development activity provides denturists with a rewarding opportunity to work together in a group to address challenging, topical practice issues and develop enhanced problem-solving approaches and strategies.

Peer Circles typically involve 8 practitioners and a group facilitator. The facilitator, who is a practising denturist, is trained to assist the group as it considers these instructive cases or issues.

Members of the profession have been involved in the development of this activity over the winter. One of the final steps in the development process is running a few pilot sessions. These pilot sessions will provide the College with an opportunity to fine tune the activity before it is provided to the whole membership.
